The Rencontre Châteauguoise change its name

The Rencontre Châteauguoise is established in the community of Châteauguay since 1990 and its mission is to “to create a place of welcome and exchange open to all, especially to people living in a situation of vulnerability in order to break isolation, share and obtain the necessary tools to improve their living conditions and their autonomy”.

After reflection, the organization decided to change its social identity. The organization by name, could suggest that the territory served was only the city of Châteauguay. To clarify the territory covered by the organization, it was determined that it was important to include “du Grand Châteauguay” in the new name.

This was an important aspect that caught the attention of the staff and board members during the consultations for the selection of the new name.



The term “glimmer of hope” was mentioned several times by participants in the various activities

The word “spark” was chosen because it encapsulates the sentiment created by our participants.

Bien équipé pour la rentrée 2024

Offered by **Entraide Mercier**, this program is aimed at low-income families in the region. It enables families with children from kindergarten to grade 5 to receive the following items free of charge: backpacks, exercise books, binders, notebooks, pencils, etc... to get the school year off on the right foot.

How do I register:

Step 1

Present the following documents:

1. Copy of your Revenu Québec 2023 notice of assessment and the other parent or spouse, if applicable.
2. Copy of the Avis de l'allocation famille du Québec.
3. Proof of residence.
4. Copy of the list of school supplies required by the school for each child you wish to enroll. On each list, cross out the items you already have. Reuse from previous year's school supplies is encouraged.

Your notice of assessment not reflect the precariousness of your situation. You can still contact one of our partner organizations to discuss your situation.
